

Cordova Trail and Covered Spaces

The Cordova Trail and Covered Outdoor Spaces Project is a shared community vision that has been proposed in multiple ways for many years. The mission of the project is to create day use covered spaces along the Orca Inlet and Eyak Lake existing roadway waterfronts at visually beautiful, educational and culturally important viewpoints with interpretive signs and links for learning more.



Beginning at Orca Bay near the Orca Adventure Lodge, The Cordova Trail continues along the Copper River Highway to Whitshed Road then to Hartney Bay with a spur from downtown Cordova and out Power Creek Road along the Eyak Lake waterfront.
